As we approach the end of this academic year, we are excited to share important updates. You may have heard about our recent campus expansion opportunities with the adjacent property on Cassady Drive.

This newly acquired space, dedicated to our Maternelle program (PreK-3 through Kindergarten), will be set to open in August 2025. We are thrilled to announce that improvements are already underway including HVAC system replacements in progress now and security updates scheduled over the next couple of weeks! In addition, Mr. Cedric and the Maternelle teachers are working diligently to ensure that the larger classrooms provide the strong learning environment that helps us deliver our excellent program. The AEFE French inspector will be on campus on May 14th-15th to help us ensure our expansion reflects the excellence and integrity of our French accreditation.

Starting August 14th, 2025, students in the Maternelle program will attend the Cassady Campus, while all other students will remain at the Adelphi Campus. For families with children at both locations, we are finalizing coordinated drop-off and pick-up procedures, with details to be shared before the school year begins. We had a meeting with the Maternelle parents last month and are excited to engage parents in conversations about this new space.
